

After consultation with the Interim Library Director Emily Zollo, we are happy to announce that the Latham Library will be open to the public starting on Monday, July 19th, following the guidelines for [Phase 3 of the Latham Library's Reopening Plan](#). Although the pandemic is not over, the conditions have been met to allow on site access by the public to the Latham Library. Due to funds provided by grants, Latham Library has been equipped with air purifiers, a sneeze guard at the desk, and sufficient personal protection equipment. Due to generous support from the public, the Latham Library has sufficient back-up staffing in case of illness. We ask that you consider the safety of all in the community, particularly the library staff and our vulnerable populations, when deciding to visit the library in person. Please base your decision on these factors:

1. Vaccination status
2. Symptoms of COVID, such as a cold
3. Mask wearing; masks are available at the Latham Library
4. Use of the hand sanitizer available at the Latham Library
5. Travel outside the country

Curbside pick up will continue to be available, so you can access materials without having to enter the Latham Library.
